## **POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **Fish Technician I, Kitoi Bay Hatchery, Afognak Island, Kodiak Alaska**

Kodiak Regional Aquaculture Association has three (3) seasonal positions available at Kitoi Bay Hatchery for 2012. This entry level position is from April to October, season dependent. Applications accepted through **March 15, 2012** or until all positions are filled. Kitoi Bay Hatchery is a large and diverse Pacific salmon production facility (185 million pink, 28 million chum, 2 million coho and 600,000 sockeye salmon eggs) located on Afognak Island. This is a remote site approximately 25 miles north of the city of Kodiak, accessible only by floatplane or boat.

**DUTIES:** Duties include a variety of remote salmon hatchery tasks relating to freshwater and saltwater rearing of fry and smolt, juvenile transfers, incubation and egg care, adult handling and egg collection, cost recovery and general facility upkeep.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Education and/or experience in fisheries, biology or related field. Maintenance or boat operation experience is preferred. Employees must be physically fit, hands-on labor, capable of lifting and carrying 50 pounds for distances of up to 100 yards. Must be able to work in adverse weather conditions, work cooperatively in groups, or individually with little supervision.

**WAGE/BENEFITS:** This position is a full time 6 to 8 month position, depending on season. Room and board provided; seasonal employees reside in a dorm-type bunkhouse with communal kitchen and living areas. Amenities include regular mail/freight service, phone, internet, satellite TV, and exceptional outdoor recreational opportunities in the Kitoi Bay area.

- ◆ **Salary:** \$11.95 to \$15.15 per hour, DOE. Step increase following successful 3 month probationary period. Annual merit increases.
- ◆ **Benefit package** includes personal time off (PTO) paid holidays, and R&R flights to Kodiak. Long term seasonals are eligible for medical-dental-vision-prescription insurance and a 401(k) retirement plan with a generous employer contribution.
